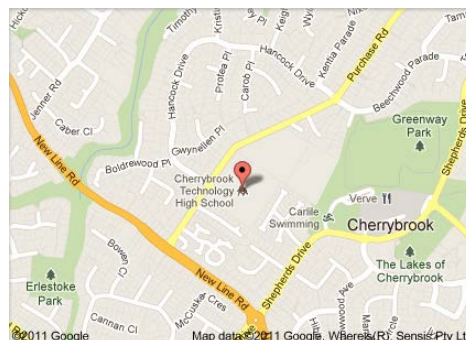

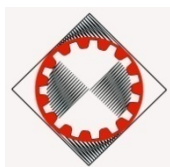

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# GENERAL INFORMATION

## ROLE OF OUR T.O.s

Each tournament has a Tournament Organiser (TO) who oversees each tournament. The TO is in charge of the running of the tournament and duties that may include scoring, judging, rules queries and managing player misconduct.

Rules queries should be directed towards your TO who may also intervene if there is a dispute. The TO should be sought out first to avoid disrupting the games of other players with your rule clarifications. Ensure you have checked the rulebook and appropriate FAQ's before seeking the TO. In consultation with the CO due to misconduct players may be spoken to directly and a warning given or with serious/repeated offences players can be docked tournament points or ejected from the convention with no refund given. The decision of the TO's and CO is final, and no discussion will be entered into.

## PAINTING STANDARDS

First and foremost, you should be the one rewarded for your painting effort. If you have hired or paid someone else to paint it for you, you will not be eligible for any sort of painting prize. Models should also be appropriately based. If the game system has requirements for base sizes these are to be followed, or miniatures may need to be removed.

## CANTEEN

On both days of the tournament there will be a canteen available all day to all participants of *Clash of the Titans*. Prices and availability subject to change.

You will not be asked to remove any models who do not meet the requirements of your game system, which may include being WYSIWYG (what you see is what you get). This means that weapons, armour options and upgrades chosen from the army list must be shown on characters and on the majority of the models in a unit or squad.

## BEHAVIOUR

Remember the convention is an inclusive event and the meeting place for a range of ages. On that basis, please make sure your behaviour (including language) is appropriate for all ages. This extends to apparel – if your T-shirt, jacket etc could possibly cause offence, please leave it at home.

**Please remember that as this is held on Department of Education property, and that school students are playing and working at the event, absolutely NO alcohol, drugs or cigarettes are to be brought onto or consumed on the premises. Zero tolerance will be used on any persons found to be disregarding this warning. This extends to persons suspected of being under the influence of said items.**

## AWARDS CEREMONY

The Awards Ceremonies take place after the terrain boards have been packed away at the conclusion of the final game for each individual tournament. We urge players to stay for their awards ceremony if they possibly can, so that they can cheer the winners and commiserate with the losers! The prizes are based on a minimum number of participants to make the prizes viable. Due to the uncertainty of entry numbers, some awards may only be given as a certificate. We will make every effort to give out as many prizes as possible, but sometimes it's just not financially viable. On the other side of the coin, however, if we receive a large number of entrants it will be possible to include more prizes. We do the **Best Painted**, **Best Army Selection** and **Best Sportsman** awards because our hobby is not just about winning at all costs. It's also about having fun, being considerate of your opponent's enjoyment, painting nice armies and playing in a friendly and sporting manner.
